



## 2008 – 2009 Open Enrollment and Schools for Advanced Studies (SAS) Permits

### March 3 – April 4, 2008

**Open Enrollment Applications** are available in the Granada Hills Charter High School Attendance Office or on line. The application deadline is noon on April 4, 2008. Open Enrollment applications will be accepted in the Attendance Office

**SAS Applications** are available in the Counseling Office or on line. Submit applications signed by the school of attendance and attach proof of eligibility for the SAS program. Proof of eligibility must show gifted identification and/or the appropriate test scores. The application deadline is noon on April 4, 2008. SAS applications will be accepted in the Counseling Office.

Both applications are available to download at [www.ghchs.com](http://www.ghchs.com) beginning March 3, 2008.

### April 8, 2008

The drawing for both permits will begin in the Attendance Office at 10:00 a.m. and will be open to the public. Attendance is not required.

### April 11, 2008

Notification of selected applicants will begin. A waiting list will be established, and as openings become available, selected students will be notified.

Transportation is NOT provided with these permits. Contact the Counseling Office for eligibility requirements for the SAS program. A limited number of spaces are available for both Open Enrollment and SAS. If the number of applicants exceeds the available spaces, a random selection process (drawing) will be held. Only one entry per permit, per student is permitted. The application will be disqualified if more than one entry is submitted. All incoming 9<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup> graders must attend the 2008 Summer Transition Academy, a GHCHS graduation requirement beginning with the class of 2011. For more information about the Summer Transition Academy, please go to [www.ghchs.com](http://www.ghchs.com). Students who are selected will be notified by mail. After reaching the authorized number of permits, all of the remaining names will be drawn and placed on a waiting list. If a student becomes eligible from the waiting list, he/she will be notified. Due to the volume of applicants, we are unable to answer phone inquiries pertaining to the results of the drawing. The acceptance lists and waiting lists will be posted at GHCHS in the Attendance Office.
