VII. Board Issues & Updates:

A. Review and approval of U.S. Bank purchasing card transactions, bank statement,

November monthly expenditures and budget report including potential reallocations and unencumberances to existing budget (Brandon Schindelheim).

- B. Discussion and possible Board action to approve an additional amount not to exceed \$800 for a December Newsletter. Bids for the Newsletter have exceeded the initial allotment of \$4000. Funds to be allocated from Election Outreach as most of the Newsletter will be dedicated to that purpose.
- C. Discussion and possible Board action to approve a Neighborhood Purpose Grant to Friends of the Library in the amount of \$3,000. Friends of the Library is a non-profit 501c3 organization dedicated to support of the Granada Hills Library. Funds will be used to purchase additional books for the library.
- D. Discussion and possible Board action to suspend Article XI, Section 6 of the By-Laws, and postpone the report of the Grievance Panel to the January meeting. Status of participation in December 8, 2013 Holiday parade.

Planning and Land Use Committee (Jerry Askew)

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- A. Committee recommendation In regard to 17501 Devonshire, an existing Synagogue, an addition requiring reduced parking and a reduced rear yard setback (ZA-2013-3494-CU-ZV-ZAA): Letter to City Planning indicating that applicant has been non-responsive and requesting postponement of hearing to allow time for discussions with applicant or for the NC to ascertain the impact of the project.
- B. Committee recommendation in regard to 17901 Chatsworth, addition of a recycling facility at the rear of the existing Ralphs Market (DIR-2013-3550-DRB-SPP): Recommendation to City Planning and Applicant to confer with Granada Hills Charter High School and a) consider relocation of facility to the west so as to minimize interference with school offices and/or library; b) consider impact and possible mitigations of facility operations on pick-up and drop-off activity and associated traffic and pedestrian safety around the school; c) coordinate hours of operation with school so as to minimize interferences with school operations; and d) Conform facility to newly submitted guidelines for recycling facilities (including construction of a permanent structure, enclosed facility etc). Committee to review existing "Q" conditions on property and report on compliance.
- C. Committee recommendation in regard to 10324 Balboa, addition of on-site sale of alcohol at new Chipolte restaurant under construction (ZA-2013-3514-CUB): Letter to City Planning indicating that the applicant requested that we postpone the item until our December meeting and request that Planning not schedule the hearing until we have had the opportunity to meet with the applicant. In the event that a hearing is held prior to that time, our position is one of opposition to the project.
