Studies in a growing body of knowledge have highlighted the great need moving forward for high school graduates to choose technology related di sciplines in college such as computer programming and various types of engineering. These same studies have shown a positive impact on stude nt participants of competition robotics in their academics as well as sustained interest in science and technology related education and careers. It was noted in one such study that, "robotics has a strong appeal to this intensely competitive generation and represents the perfect storm of applie d physics, mathematics, computer programming, digital prototyping and design, integrated problem solving, teamwork and thought leadership."

To take this endeavor further, over the last two years, VAAS students have created a mentorship opportunity with the budding Patrick Henry Middle School Robotics Program. We conducted three field trips to PHMS where VAAS students presented interactive and instructive displays focused on robotic subsystems and related concepts. 
