Note that any stakeholder comments must be made during the appropriate public comment period, and either du individual's allotted time or if an individual stakeholder has been invited to speak by a board member. Audience member not approach the board during a meeting except to hand out materials during the allotted speaking time, and then only we permission of the presiding officer. If a stakeholder has any requests that cannot be addressed during the allotted speaking the items may be e--mailed to the board or to our Secretary. Note that Government Code section 54957.9 provides: In the event that any meeting is willfully interrupted by a group or groups of persons so as to render the orderly conduct meeting unfeasible and order cannot be restored by the removal of individuals who are willfully interrupting the meeting members of the legislative body conducting the meeting may order the meeting room cleared and continue in session matters appearing on the agenda may be considered in such a session. Representatives of the press or other news media, those participating in the disturbance, shall be allowed to attend any session held pursuant to this section. Nothing in this shall prohibit the legislative body from establishing a procedure for readmitting an individual or individuals not respons willfully disturbing the orderly conduct of the meeting.

## Please note further that Penal Code section 403 states:

Every person who, without authority of law, willfully disturbs or breaks up any assembly or meeting that is not up in its character, other than an assembly or meeting referred to in Section 302 of the Penal Code or Section 18340 Elections Code, is guilty of a misdemeanor.

The board reserves its rights to exercise appropriate remedies in the event of disruption of board or committee meetings.
