Discussion and possible recommendation to the Board regarding Capital Improvement Project funding by the Granada Hills South Neighborhood Council of security improvements at the Granada Hills Recreation Center (i.e. ‘Petit Park,’) including but not limited to the park, the gymnasium, the pool, and the Granada Hills Library, in the amount of up to \$5000.
- B. Background – On July 19, 2023, there was a homicide at Petit Park. On Sept. 14, 2023, representatives of the Los Angeles Police Department, City of Los Angeles Department of Recreation and Parks, the City of Los Angeles Public Library system, and the City of Los Angeles Department of Neighborhood Empowerment spoke in regards to the murder and on-going security and safety issues at the recreation center at regular monthly meeting of the Granada Hills South Neighborhood Council.
- C. During the meeting, city staff reported there is no security camera system at the park; the same city staff members suggested the GHSNC consider supporting installation of such a system through a designated Capital Improvement Project.
